#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- 1. 2015 CCA Regional Road race Re-cap
  - a. Overall participation entries 366
  - **b.** Volunteer count was approximately 46 separate volunteers over two days not counting the Setup and prep on Friday before the race weekend.
  - c. Income versus expenses
    - i. From looking at the 'Money In vs Money Out' for the weekend, it costs about \$5000.00 per day to host and put on a race
    - ii. Bob, Mike T and Michael Roberts have a detailed balance sheet for the race weekend.
  - d. AAR points and discussion to improve event
    - i. Overall the feedback for the weekend was pretty positive. The racers, for the most part enjoyed the course and the people at the event, and the venue.
    - ii. There were a few comments that the course 'was not hilly' enough didn't provide ample opportunity to break of the fields for example
      - 1. Counterpoint the race is in Eastern NC, there are very few hills in this area, and even further east.
      - **2.** Counterpoint the feedback from the same race last year was good, so the course was kept the same, you do not want to 'test a course' on a championship event.
    - iii. Parking need better supervision of the parking situation in the field cones perhaps defining lanes etc, and volunteers to direct and assist in parking
    - iv. Pace Cars it was suggested to use the pace cars to assist in blocking the road (far up from the finish line) for the final sprint, since the sprint, from 200m out is allowed to use both lanes. This way the racers have time to decelerate without having to worry about getting hit by oncoming traffic.
    - v. Better traffic control in turn 4 especially on the final lap so vehicles don't interfere with the final sprint. Contingency plan for train crossing with cars backing up on the course there needs to be a way to get them off the race course or 'control' the stopped cars so the race can go on around them before they move.
    - vi. Bike support available we had the Hawley's van but no mechanic.
    - vii. Volunteer Scheduling this year the volunteers for the course were scheduled by time slot, and there were a few times where the volunteers were on course and no race going on suggest to schedule course marshals and volunteers by race, not by time slot.
