



Cross Creek Cycling Club History

Founded in 2003 by a small, but very enthusiastic group of local cyclists, the Cross Creek Cycling Club (known as C4) has grown to be the largest cycling club in the area at 145 cyclist. Enjoying an active, healthy, and fun lifestyle, the club is dedicated to promoting the sport of cycling and broadening its appeal to male, female, senior, and junior cyclists of all abilities and ages. Our membership is as diverse as anyone can imagine with our teenage riders to our most mature at 60+. Many of our members are active duty or retired military, who, with their family members, enjoy the sport of cycling within a club environment.

We have accomplished many key things that not only enhanced the club but also our community. C4 members volunteered and participated in many community and charitable events like; Mike to Mike Marathon, Wounded Warrior Project; Ride to Recovery; Cumberland and Scotland Counties Habitat for Humanity, and many others. We have also raised more than \$100,000 in support of multiple charitable organizations including the Eastern North Carolina Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society. We are very proud of our C4 members as they have dedicated time annually to support the Moses Mathis Christmas Bicycleman Giveaway, providing countless hours of mechanical support to ensure each child receives a working bike that would otherwise not have the opportunity to own one. In years past, we've provided coaches and partners for the Cumberland County Special Olympics program. There have been many other ride and non-ride activities that have supported the community and club in positive ways.

We are also a USA Cycling (USAC) sanctioned club. A few significant accomplishments we were very proud to receive were selection by USA Cycling as "Best New Club of the Year" for 2004. For 2007, USA Cycling selected C4 for two awards: the 2007 Masters Club of the Year and 2007 Division III Club of the Year; two awards again for 2008: Division II and Masters Club of the year; 2009 Division II club of the Year; 2005, 2007, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 Masters Club of the Year. From anyone's knowledge, a single club has never received two awards in the same year. Only one club in the nation receives these awards per year and is a testament to the positive efforts of our members. Currently we have more than 15 USCA Cycling license holders that race throughout the region. During 2004, we hosted a time trial training series, an all category 40-kilometer time trial, as well as a 62-mile training road race on the roads of Fort Bragg. During 2005, we held the Dragon's Challenge Road Race and Time Trial on Fort Bragg, NC that attracted more than 200 racers. In addition, C4, with the support of the Fayetteville Downtown Alliance and the City of Fayetteville, re-energized racing in the downtown area with the Patriot's Criterium that included world ranked riders. For two years we raised the bar for the Dragon's Challenge by making it a \$10,000, three-event weekend. These events brought in over 550 riders from all over the country as well as the professional team "Team Monex". For 2007, 2008 and 2009, the Carolina's Cycling Association awarded the hosting of NC State Criterium to C4 which was very successful in downtown Fayetteville, and co-host/sponsored the Tour de Moore Road Race from 2009-2014 also, for 2014 and 2015 we hosted the NC Road Race Championship weekend. We are immensely proud to have hosted the 2019 CCA Regional Time Trial Championship boasting the largest field of cyclist to date. While COVID-19 produced challenges for everyone, including giving us a shorten race seasons, we did conduct the 2020 CCA Regional Time Trial Championship having 102 racers by far the largest the CCA has seen. In 2021, the CCA Regional Time Trial Championship had 125 participants, an increase of 18 racers from 2020. We are very excited for the opportunities in 2022 as we look to expand on this year's success and conduct an individual time trial along with a team trial.

In November of 2006, C4 was selected by Sports Illustrated magazine as the featured sports organization in a national ad campaign for the U.S. Army. This of course brought an enormous amount of attention when this was published in the November 2006 issue.

Hawley's Bicycle World Race Team

Over the past 10 years Hawley's race team has represented the Fayetteville/Fort Bragg community in races throughout the east coast. The team races year-round in four cycling disciplines; Gravel, Mountain, Cyclocross, and Road. In total, members participate in roughly 40-50 race events each year. The team had an exceptional 2021 season as they competed in 47 races during which we had twenty-two Top 10 Finishes, thirteen of which were Top 5 Finishes. We are dedicated to building relationships that will support local events, our athletes, and the team; and most importantly, endorse and promote our sponsor's product and services. Our team is looking toward the future with high goals and determination for continued success.
